

The Palace Museum: A Living Fossil of Ming and Qing Imperial Culture




Architectural Art: The most complete surviving wooden palace complex, with meticulous layout and exquisite details.

Live Reenactments: Recreating the life and governance of Ming and Qing emperors, immersing visitors in royal culture.










Jingshan Park: The Highest Point on the Central Axis

Live Demonstrations: Inheritors perform on-site, allowing visitors to interact and experience.















APM Mall: Gathering international luxury brands, experiencing modern commercial culture.










Gardens and Water Systems Tour

Shichahai: The Fusion of Old Beijing and New Culture




